The Keating Township Supervisors met on November 4, 2015 at 6:00 pm in the Township Building with Chairman Chapman bringing the meeting to order and leading the Pledge of Allegiance. Supervisors Chapman, Sweeley & McClain, Sec’y Smith, and nine (9) township residents attended the meeting.

- 1) A motion was made by Supv Sweeley/2<sup>nd</sup> Chapman, to approve payment of Requisition No. 22. Motion carried unanimously.
- 2) A memo was read from Eric Casanave regarding Phase II WWTP project. Konzel Construction is about 92% and C & R Directional Boring is about 95% complete.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

- 1) The proposed 2016 Annual Budget will be available for review from November 11<sup>th</sup> to December 2<sup>nd</sup>.
- 2) There no increase on our 2016 Renewal of Highmark Eye Insurance.
- 3) A motion was made by Supv Chapman/2<sup>nd</sup> McClain, to approve Danzer Forestland, Inc. major subdivision on State Route 59. Motion carried unanimously.
- 4) Repository Sale Map Number 24-003-206 was awarded to Denyel D. Obrien and Mark E. Lawton was motion by Supv Chapman/2<sup>nd</sup> McClain. Motion carried unanimously.
- 5) Repository Sale Map Number 24-003-212-11 was denied because both bidders bid the same amount, motion by Supv Chapman/2<sup>nd</sup> McClain. Motion carried unanimously.

- 7) Supervisor’s agreed to start getting things in order to advertise for a WWTP Operator as of the first of the year.
- 8) Sec/Tres Treasurer Bond was renewed for 2016. She is bonded for \$800,000.00
- 9) A motion was made by Supv Chapman/2<sup>nd</sup> McClain for the Building Permit for John and Judy Stratton at 2296 East Valley Road. Motion carried unanimously.
- 10) A Building Permit for James and Rhonda Duffy at 11 Kleisath Road was approved by motioned by Supv Chapman/2<sup>nd</sup> McClain. Motion carried unanimously.
