

The Keating Township Supervisors met on July 23rd, 2018 at 5:00 pm in the Township Building with Supv Doug Covert bringing the Special Meeting to order and leading the Pledge of Allegiance. Supervisor McClain, Supervisor Wheeler, Sec'y Smith and five (5) township residents attended the meeting.

PUBLIC HEARD:

1. Jerry Gorrell explained his property line situation again, and Supv Covert explained that the Township will not be part of a property line dispute. The problem allies between Mr. Jones and Mr. Gorrell. Supv Covert expressed that the grinder pump, tank and accessories are owned by Keating Township. If something becomes damage then it will fall back onto Mr. Gorrell.
2. Emery Gallup wanted to know the status of the 2002 Ford 550. Supv Covert stated the truck has been fixed in house and has passed inspection.

NEW BUSINESS:

- 1) A motion by Supv Wheeler/2nd Covert to keep the existing UPMC Healthcare for Township Employees. Motion carried unanimously.
- 2) A motion by Supv Covert/2nd Wheeler to have Sec-Treas Smith start acquired proposals on future bridge projects per Roadmaster prioritize list so she can start applying for other bridge grants. Motion carried unanimously. Sec-Treas Smith is planning on applying to McKean County Act 13 Bridge at Risk Grant this fall.
- 3) Sec-Treas Smith went over the McKean County Fee for Local Use Fund with Supervisors. There will be a special meeting on this Local Use Fee on August 8th at 5pm at McKean County 911 Building.
- 4) Sec-Treas Smith ask Supervisor what they thought about redacting all 5 of the LST Ordinances and adopt a new Ordinances will all detail in one place. Currently you need to look at 5 different Ordinance to have all the correct details. Sec-Treas Smith has a call into PSATS, Holly Fishel and also solicitor Alfieri was going to read thru them and let Sec-Treas Smith know if we can redact and adopt a new one.
